STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to assist you think through your options and make choices based upon like for like comparisons between funeral directors - charges can vary.

ATTENDED FUNERAL - *Funeral Director's Charges only*

£ 1,995

This is a funeral where the ceremony or service for the person who has died takes place at the same time as their burial or cremation.

- Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements £ 700
- Collecting and transporting the person who has died from place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care. £ 195
- Care of the person who has died in appropriate facilities. The deceased will be kept at our Funeral Home. £ 390
- Providing a suitable coffin. This will be a light oak effect coffin (suitable for burial or cremation) £ 285
- Viewing of the deceased by family & friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing has been requested) £ 75
- At a mutually agreed date and time, we will convey the person who has died directly to the agreed local cemetery or crematorium in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle. £ 350

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where burial or cremation takes place with no mourners in attendance and a ceremony or service (if required) takes place separately.

Burial (Funeral Directors Charges Only)

£ 1,150

Cremation (Funeral Directors Charges and Cremation Fee)

£ 1,967

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial, the burial charges ¹: £ 300 - £320

In the Causeway Coast & Glens area, the typical charge for the burial of local residents is: £320

For a new grave, you will also need to purchase the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the Cemetery/Churchyard may charge other fees for various services.

For an Attended cremation, the cremation charge ²: £ 642

In this local area, the typical cremation charge is: £ 642

¹ This fee (sometimes referred to as the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees. This is a charge made by two doctors to complete the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
